


## of the electronic version of the journal "Uspekhi Fizicheskikh Nauk" ("Physics – Uspekhi")



The website (www.ufn.ru) of the journal Uspekhi Fizicheskikh Nauk (UFN) was started a quarter of a century ago (December 26, 1994). Statistics on UFN site visits have been kept since March of 1995, allowing the UFN team to see for the first time how many readers we have, where they are from, and what their interests and preferences are. After a year (in 1996), in the same editorial note we wrote proudly that within one year the UFN site had been visited several thousand times. By January of 2000, UFN site visits had already amounted to hundreds of thousands. In 2001-2003, supported by an RFBR grant, the UFN website already contained the whole Russian-language UFN archive from 1918. In 2006–2007, the UFN journal (the first among all the scientific journals in the Russian Federation) began assigning a DOI (Digital Object Identifier) to the electronic versions of Russian-language papers, and in 2014-2016, supported by the Ministry of Education and Science (in the framework of a contest to support RF scientific journals), the DOI was already assigned to the entire archive of UFN papers from 1918. The DOI allowed us to collect references to the papers

published in UFN and to join references to the Russian and English versions of one and the same paper. The lists of such papers that cited UFN can be found on the UFN website with reference to each paper. By January 2020, the UFN website had been visited by 5.7 million unique users (with different IP-addresses), the number of visits exceeding 17 million (over 2 million visits in 2019 alone); the pages on the UFN site had been looked through by readers over 250 million times. The statistics on *UFN* site visits (yearly) is presented below in the graph. More than 30% of all site visits now come from the USA, next comes Russia (25%), then Germany, Ukraine, China, France, Great Britain, South Korea, Italy, and others. Note that the files of UFN papers are also placed in the Mathnet.ru platform and in Elibrary.ru, while the English UFN version is located on the IOP site (https://iopscience.iop.org/journal/1063-7869). Our statistics show that UFN papers are interesting and useful to physicists all over the world. We are thankful to all 8088 authors who had published 11,361 papers in UFN (by January 2020), to all the thoughtful readers, and to those who simply stopped by the UFN site.
